John McDouall Stuart

The most notable influence to the development of South Australia was in the field of exploration by a remarkable man, namely John McDouall Stuart, whose contribution to this state is recognised by a statue to his memory in Victoria Square. This statue was donated to the City of Adelaide by the South Australian Caledonian Society (now the Royal Caledonian Society of S.A.)

Accolades such as “the explorations of Stuart” may truly be said, without disparaging his brother explorers, to be among the most important in the history of Australian discovery.

Stuart, born in Dysart in 1815 (Dysart is on the Northern shore of the Firth of Fourth, almost directly opposite Edinburgh) ultimately graduated as a civil engineer. He came to SA in 1839 and worked for the Government Survey Department. 1844 saw him part of the Captain Charles Sturt expedition in search of an inland sea.

Stuart commanded the SA Great Northern Exploring Expedition in the years 1861 - 1863, which completed the first crossing of Australia from Adelaide to Van Dieman Gulf, passing through the centre and returning along the same route without loss of life.

He undertook 6 expeditions between May 1858 and January 1863 and on his last attempt, succeeded in raising the flag on the north coast of Chambers Bay on 25th July 1862.

The return journey of 3,200km was a great feat of survival as Stuart’s health failed, but all of his party returned safely to Adelaide.

Stuart returned to the U.K., and died aged 50 years on 5th June 1866, and is buried near Governor Sir Richard Graves MacDonnell in Kensal Green Cemetery London. He had named the MadDonnell Ranges in the Northern Territory after the Governor.

Stuart’s expedition resulted in South Australia gaining control of the Northern Territory and establishing the settlement we know today as Darwin. (Escape Cliffs)

The overland telegraph line linked Adelaide to Europe via Darwin and was constructed along his route, 1872. Likewise the Central Australian railway (The Ghan) from Adelaide to Alice Springs.

Vast areas of the north were opened up for pastoral and mineral development.

The Stuart Highway linking Adelaide to Darwin was named in his honour and sections closely follow the route he blazed. Surely a remarkable contribution to the benefit of South Australia.

Discover the ship that changed South Australia and is one of Port Adelaide’s finest visitor attractions! The Clipper Ship “City of Adelaide”

The City of Adelaide is the world’s oldest surviving Clipper Ship and played a significant role in the colonial history of South Australia.

Constructed in 1864 to carry passengers to Adelaide, South Australia, she carried immigrants from places such as England, Scotland, Cornwall, Ireland, Germany and Scandinavia and made 23 return voyages. With a composite construction it was the pinnacle of sailing ship design. Only two survive today, the younger being the Cutty Sark Recovered from Scotland after a 14 year campaign to save the vessel, the City of Adelaide arrived in Adelaide in February 2014.

It is planned that the City of Adelaide will be the centrepiece of a Seaport Village, offering the perfect interactive environment for visitors to learn about Australian maritime and colonial history. The Village, in addition to maritime and colonial displays, will reflect the cultures of the passengers and crew.

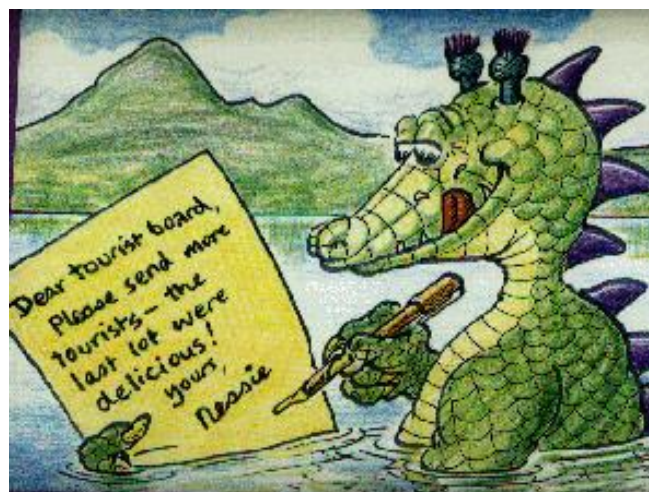
